ConsCallHome.com uses VoIP call routing technology to lower the costs of inmate calls to ConsCallHome.com customers, enabling inmates and family members the ability to talk at affordable telephone rates. The new ConsCallHome products will be effective beginning April 16, 2014 and will continue for an indefinite amount of time.

Alarming, there are 12 million people who cycle through the nation's correctional facilities every year, and 2.7 million children with an incarcerated parent. Many of these children who are already suffering from familial separation are often prevented from talking to a parent simply because of the high cost of telephone calls. To set up this service, the subscriber must have a prepaid account with the prison phone provider; however, *ConsCallHome will provide the cost saving phone number for free.* No credit card is required to receive the free calls, but for security purposes identification information will be required.
